What is the “Beyond Use Date” on Bottles?

You will receive your prescription with a BUD of at least 30 days.

How long can I use the dropper or bottle?

The dropper can be used for 28 days after opening OR by the beyond-use date listed on the dropper bottle, whichever is shorter. Any product left in the dropper after this time should be discarded.

Do I need to request a refill each month?

If you are enrolled in the automatic refill program, you do not need to request a refill. Your prescription will automatically be charged, filled, and mailed to you when it is due.

What to do if you are not enrolled in auto-refill

You can request a refill through your secure text message link, or you can use this QR code to sign in through our website.

What are some other side effects of this drug?

All drugs may cause side effects. However, many people have no side effects or only have minor side effects. Call your child’s doctor or get medical help if any of these side effects bother your child or do not go away:

- Blurred eyesight
- Stinging
- Eye irritation
- Dry mouth, skin, or eyes
- These are not all of the side effects that may occur.

If you have questions about side effects, call your child’s doctor.

How should I store the bottle of Atropine Sulfate?

Valor has conducted stability studies which show that the solution is safe to store at room temperature.

We are going on vacation, how do I make sure we have our medication on time?

Notify our pharmacy at least two weeks ahead of time if you plan to be out of town to make sure we have time to prepare and ship your custom made compound before you leave, so you never miss a dose.

ADDITIONAL FAQ'S AND ATROPINE SULFATE INFORMATION

What is the pricing for Atropine Sulfate?

The pricing for Atropine Sulfate is \$50 per 5ml for a 30-day supply.

What do I do if I miss a dose?

- Give a missed dose as soon as you think about it.
- If it is close to the time for your child's next dose, skip the missed dose and go back to your child's normal time.
- Do not give 2 doses at the same time or extra doses.

How to administer Atropine Sulfate

- Wash hands before and after use.
- Have your child take out contact lenses before using the drug. Talk with the doctor to see when lenses may be put back in after this drug is given. Do not put lenses back in if your child's eyes are irritated or infected.
- Tilt your child's head back and drop drug into the eye.
- After giving this drug, ask your child to keep eye closed. Put light pressure on the inside corner of the eye. Do this for 1 to 2 minutes. This keeps the drug in your child's eye.
- It is important for your child to be still whilst you administer the eye drops.
- For older children, gently pull the lower lid out and squeeze the bottle gently so that one drop goes into the pocket that is formed.
- In small children and babies, place the drop into the inner corner of the eye. This is easier with the eye open, but the liquid will still drain onto the eye even with a closed eye if you can hold your child's head still for a few seconds.
- Hold the bottle as reasonably close to the eye as possible, without the tip touching your child's eye.
- After giving eye drops, your child should keep their eye closed for as long as they can (5 seconds if possible) so that the eye drop doesn't spill out.
- If you think the drop didn't go into the eye, you can repeat the process but do not try more than twice.
- Wash your hands again with soap and hot water.
